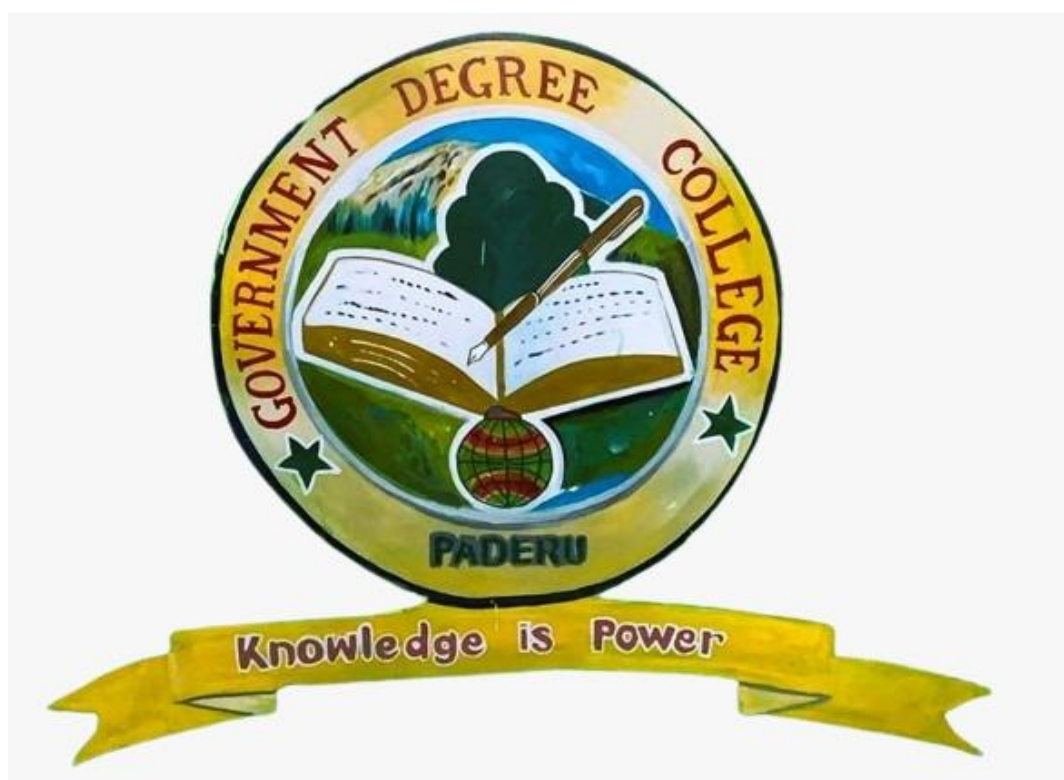

Group Discussions:

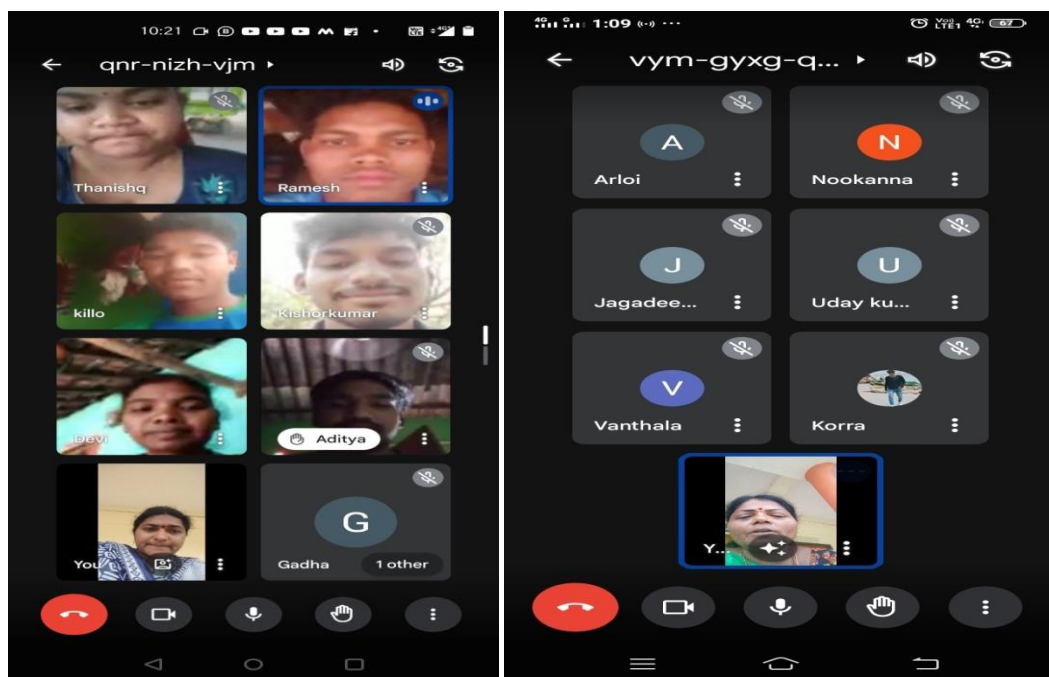


Group discussions on different topics of the subject are arranged and students are encouraged to participate in them in order to develop their subject knowledge and communication skills.
